Chuck Herring is a partner in the law firm of Herring & Panzer, L.L.P. in Austin. He is certified in Civil Trial Law by the Texas Board of Legal Specialization. He served two terms on the Texas Supreme Court's Advisory Committee, and chaired the Texas Supreme Court's Statewide Task Force on Sanctions. He served on the Supreme Court's Grievance Oversight Committee from 2010-2014. Since 1990 he has written sixteen editions of *Texas Legal Malpractice and Lawyer Discipline*, and he is coauthor of *Texas Guide To Lawyer Disqualification* (2016) and coauthor *Handbook on Texas Discovery Practice*. He has written many articles on legal malpractice, legal ethics, and litigation topics, and has taught and lectured extensively on those subjects.

Mr. Herring received the First Annual Professionalism Award from the Texas Center for Legal Ethics (TCLE) and the Travis County Bar Association, and he received a Presidential Citation from the State Bar of Texas for his service as Chair of the Committee on the Prevention of Legal Malpractice and Grievances. He regularly teaches courses for the Texas Center for Legal Ethics, and has served as an Examiner for the ABA Standing Committee on Legal Specialization for the Lawyer Liability Examination.

He has handled general litigation and legal malpractice litigation on both sides of the docket, and he regularly advises lawyers and law firms on legal ethics issues. He received a B.A. with Highest Honors from the University of Texas at Austin, and also attended the University of Texas School of Law, graduating with Honors. He received his law license in 1975.
