The Legal Services Division is responsible for working with market participants in finding solutions to new and unique regulatory issues, briefing Commissioners on regulatory matters in uncontested proceedings, working with legislators seeking assistance in drafting language for legislation, and participating as a party in contested cases before the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Commission, often leading the parties to settlements prior to hearing. In September 2014, the regulation of water ratemaking and CCN's was transferred from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to the PUCT. The PUCT now oversees the utility sectors of telephone, electricity and water.
